

Calvary Community Church COVID-19 Safety Plan

In accordance with government restrictions and for your protection, the following guidelines will be in place for in-person worship gathering on Sundays at 9:30am. These guidelines are subject to change depending on the status of the outbreak.

Safety Disclaimer:

Individuals who are susceptible to illness (for example due to age over 65, diabetes, heart disease, breathing issues, weakened immune system) should continue to attend via live streaming from home.

Anyone who is experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms should stay home.

Anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 after attending a service should alert us immediately so we can notify others of the exposure.

Safety Measures:

- Social distancing will be encouraged through clear signage and volunteer personnel
 - The entire building will be disinfected prior to gathering each week
 - Doors will be propped open to avoid multiple touches
 - Hand sanitizer stations are available at the entrance and throughout the building
 - No bulletins will be handed out or offering plates passed during the service
- (An offering box is available just outside the sanctuary doors in addition to electronic giving)

Safety Guidelines:

- There will be one entrance (back door at North-West corner of the building – follow signs)
- Please plan on arriving between 9-9:15am to line up, socially distancing as household units
- Face masks will be required (we will have extras available should you forget yours)
- Temperatures will be taken prior to entering the building with a non-contact thermometer (anyone with a temperature over 100 degrees will not be admitted)
- Household units will be seated from front to back and dismissed in reverse order
- Believe it or not, avoid singing (maybe try clapping and/or raising hands?)
- Please avoid handshakes, hugs, and the like (maybe try an air high 5?)
- Downstairs bathrooms will be available if absolutely necessary
- Socializing prior to or after the worship service should take place outside of the building (while maintaining social distancing recommendations)
